

News Advs Bring Results

HUNSMASSTROOPS ON WESTERN FRONT

Believe Teutons Are Preparing For Great Drive Against Allied Lines.

UNCLE SAM MUST SPEED

Secretary of War Does Not Seek to Convey Anxiety Over Situation—Germans Are Concentrating Guns, Men and Munitions.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 11.—Germany has massed on the western front her greatest army of the war. Secretary Baker declares in his weekly war review made public today. To meet this menace, the United States must speed up its military preparations, the secretary adds, with a warning that the enemy is preparing to put into execution in France plans he has been maturing since the defeat of the Russian armies at Tannenberg early in the war. The peace negotiations with Russia have permitted the massing of men on the western front for that purpose.

The review asserts that German counter-offensive on the Canadian front has been successful in winning back less than one-third of the territory captured by General Brusilov. The statement also notes that American engineers troops, exchanging shovels for rifles, fought off the enemy side by side with the French.

The result of the German mobilization of strength is then taken as "This German move is the most powerful and successful blow aimed at the British during the past two and one-half years, coming as it did immediately after the British victory in the same area, serves to emphasize the growing strength of the Germans in the west."

INDIANS SEEK FUNDS AID STOCK RAISING

(By Associated Press.)

KLAMATH FALLS, Ore., Dec. 12.—Three Indians of the Klamath reservation—Harrison Brown, Fred Hendrie and Levi Walker, recently elected delegates to represent the Klamath tribe in Washington—have been granted the expenses of \$100 for the trip and will leave here Tuesday for the east. They will take up matters of tribal interest with the Indian department.

The efforts of the tribe of red men will be directed to securing funds with which to stimulate stock raising and skin industries. An attempt also will be made to secure a sum for distribution of tribal assets.

Frank Kitch, an Indian of advanced age and progressive spirit, has announced that he will soon visit Wasilla, Alaska, the special repressor of the Indians members of the tribe who have received parents and relatives who desire to bring about a partition of the tribal estate. Kitch expects to see his people advance funds of the government to support the Indians in the west.
