The combined merchandise store and postoffice conducted by W. H. Schroder at Arago, Coos County, was totally destroyed by fire last week, together with all but \$200 worth of goods. The net loss will be about \$2,500. This is the second time the establishment has burned down, the former fire occurring about one year ago. Both fires were believed to have been of incendiary origin. About six months ago, Mr. Schroder received an anonymous letter, threatening his establishment with destruction.
