July Weather.

The following data, covering a period of 26 years, have been compiled from the Weather Bureau records at Roseburg, Oregon. They are issued to show the conditions that have prevailed, during the month in question, for the above period of years, but must not be construed as a forecast of the weather conditions for the coming month.

Month of July for 26 years: Mean or normal temperature, 66; the warmest month was that of 1896, with an average of 71; the coldest month was that of 1884, with an average of 63; the highest temperature was 102 on 23rd, 1891; the lowest temperature was 40 on 15th, 1887.

Average precipitation for the month, 0.37 inches; average number of days with .01 of an inch or more, 3; the greatest monthly precipitation was 2.20 inches, in 1886; the least monthly precipitation was 0 inches in 1896; the greatest amount of precipitation recorded in any 24 consecutive hours was 1.27 inches on 19th and 20th, 1886.

Average number of clear days, 18; partly cloudy days, 9; cloudy days, 4; the prevailing winds have been from the northwest; the average velocity of the wind is 4.4 miles; the highest velocity of the wind was 28 miles from the southwest on 14th, 1902.

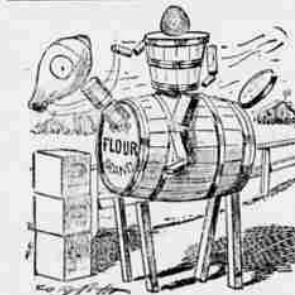
