Mr. F. B. Waite and Atty. Dexter Rice spent Sunday in Oakland. Mr. Waite returned Friday night from a ten days' trip to Spokane, Wash. He reports business active and money plentiful there at present. A main feature in bringing this about was a heavy wheat crop just being sold at good prices. Mr. Waite went to Portland last night.

Oregon Timberman: A. J. Osteon, of Glendale, has a yellow pine tree on his place which measures 27 feet in circumference at the base, and 275 feet high. It will scale about 30,000 feet. The Glendale Lumber Company, of Glendale, recently cut up a log 8 feet 3 inches in diameter at the base. The tree was 276 feet high and cut 28,000 feet of lumber. Four logs, each 16 feet in length, and one log 20 feet long, were cut from the lowest branch was reached.....Eight thousand and eighty acres of timber land, situated in township 6, range 30 south, in Umatilla County, are held by the Northwest Timber Company. The land was all transferred to the timber company by the entrymen on August 31 - the same day they secured their deeds from the Federal Government. Fifty claims were transferred for \$710 each, which cost the entrymen \$400 each.
