HOPGROWERS FORM A POOL

Undeterred by Injunction Suit Filed During Meeting.

PORTLAND, Or., April 26—Summoned to appear in the state circuit court within ten days to show cause why an injunction should not issue restraining them from forming a pool to prevent the hop market taking its "natural course," the hop growers who assembled in Portland today to effect a combination to keep up prices, went ahead with their plan, at a secret meeting of sixty growers, representing 13,895 bales of hops raised in this state from market. It is understood that the owners of 3,000 more bales, or a total of 16,895 bales of the 17,000 bales remaining unsold in this state, will also join in this movement.

Sixty of the leading growers of hops in Oregon were in attendance at the meeting. A careful canvass of "those not present" showed that only about ten growers of prominence in the state failed to attend.

A permanent organization was effected under the name of the "Oregon Hop Growers' Protective Association," with office at Salem.

The following resolutions were adopted, which state clearly the reasons for the organization and the objects it is intended to attain:

Whereas, We, the holders of hops in the State of Oregon, believing the price of hops has been maintained at its present level by means of manipulation by interested parties; and

Whereas, We believe the intrinsic value of our hops is from 30 to 40 cents per pound; and

Whereas, It is not our desire to hamper trade, but to obtain such price for our hops as existing conditions suggest we are entitled to; now therefore be it Resolved, That we, the hopgrowers of Oregon, in meeting assembled at Portland, this 25th day of April, 1905, hereby signify our intention of holding our hops until the 1st day of August, 1905, or longer, unless before that time the price of hops shall have reached over 30 cents per pound.
