Oil—Gentleness, prayer. Wine—Error, fornication. So that, according to Mrs. Eddy, the Good Samaritan poured into the man's wounds a mixture of gentleness, prayer, error and fornication.

On page 46, Mrs. Eddy gives the cure for a boil: "Now, administer mentally to your patient a high attenuation of truth, and it will cure the boil."

Some months since a little girl in Lodi, Calif., was burned so severely that every stitch of her clothing was consumed. Did her Christian Scientist parents call in a physician who could have relieved her agonies in a few seconds?
