FOREST RANGERS WANTED.

Vacancies to be Filled by Civil Service Examinations.

ROSEBURG, ORE., June 19, 1905.

EDITOR REVIEW: Will you kindly publish the following as a matter of news, as it will interest many of the readers of your paper.
The United States Civil Service Commission will hold an examination on the dates and at the places within the State of Oregon, named below, to secure eligibles from which to make certification to fill vacancies that may occur in the position of Forest Ranger in the Forest Service of the Department of Agriculture:
Baker City, Oregon, July 24, 25 and 26, 1905; Prineville, Oregon, August 1, 2 and 3; Hood River, August 9, 10, 11; Detroit, August 16, 17, 18; Grants Pass, August 23, 24, 25; Lakeview, August 31, September 1 and 2.
The examination will consist of answering practical questions in writing and in a field examination to test the ability to actually perform the duties of a forest ranger.
In the field examination applicants, among other things, will be required to shoot at target with rifle and pistol, and should bring with them these arms for the test.
The age limit will be from 21 to 40 years on the date of the examination. This examination is open to all citizens of the United States who comply with the requirements.
Applicants should at once apply to the United States Civil Service Commission, Washington, D. C., for application form 1093—Amended. No application will be accepted unless properly executed and filed in complete form, with the Commissioner at Washington. In applying for this examination the exact title of "Forest Ranger" should be used in the application.
