CHAMBERLAIN MAJORITY.

Now Placed at 1522—Heavy Vote on Amendments.

SALEM, Or., June 18.—The official returns from the recent election give Chamberlain a plurality of 1522 over Calk for United States senator.

The total number of ballots cast was in the neighborhood of 115,000 the exact number not being reported by all counties.

Owing to errors in the returns, the vote on the initiative and referendum measures has not been ascertained in full. It is shown, however, that the equal suffrage amendment was defeated by a larger majority than two years ago.

In 1906 the vote on this measure was: Yes, 36,992; no, 27,975; majority against, 10,173. The vote in 1908 was: Yes, 36,858; no, 58,670; majority against, 21,812.

The vote on the university appropriation was: Yes, 44,164; no, 40,357; majority for, 3,619. The army appropriation was defeated by a vote of 33,507 to 54,848. The free-trade bill was repudiated by a vote of 24,816 to 59,406, a majority of 30,590, or more than 2 to 1.

The single tax amendment was defeated by a vote of 22,056 for and 69,871 against, a majority of 28,805 against. The wheelmen's fish bill, antagonistic to the Lower Columbia fisheries, carried by a vote of 46,582 for and 40,720 against, a majority of 5862. The lower Columbia bill, aimed at the fish wheels, carried by a vote of 56,130 for to 30,280 against, a majority of 25,850.

One Office Left. Up in Baker county the voters did not vote for dairy and food commissioner, the candidates for that office being left off the ticket in that county.

"If the people do not want to vote there is no law that will compel them to," said Attorney General Crawford today. "Of course, should any candidate learn before election that his name had been left off the ballot he could bring mandamus proceedings and compel the county clerk to place it on the ballot. And perhaps if the

contest was a close one the candidates might demand that the county clerk put the names before the people. However, it is my opinion if the people did not vote that cannot be corrected, for you cannot make a man vote if he does not care to exercise that prerogative."

Whether the people of Baker county have discovered that this year they had no voice in the choice of a dairy commissioner has not been learned. They have evidently thought it was of little consequence, for nobody has registered a protest and the error was not discovered until the canvass of the votes in that county was made by the secretary of state.

SUNDAY SCHOOL CONGRESS.

Present System of Lessons Will not be Changed.

LOUISVILLE, Ky., June 15.—Hundreds of additional visitors arrived in Louisville today to attend the International Sunday School Convention. One of the most important matters under consideration is the report of the lesson committee, which will be acted upon by the convention tomorrow morning.

The Executive committee recommends the adoption of the "readings" of the "Boston conference," held in Boston, Jan. 2-3, 1908, when fifty prominent Sunday school leaders, representing twelve of the largest denominations and more than one-half the entire Sunday school enrollment of North America, unanimously agreed that the system of lessons now in use for the entire world, which has been in successful use for thirty-five years, is the most practical and effective system for the

graft majority of the Sunday schools of North America" and recommended "its continuance and fullest development." This conference also recognized the expressed need of a graded system of lessons, and voted to ask the Louisville convention to instruct the Lesson committee "to continue the preparation of a thoroughly graded course."

If the recommendations are adopted the convention will approve the continuance of the present uniform lesson—the same lesson for the entire school, and will also provide for a complete graded course of lessons for such schools as may desire it.

PORTLAND, Or., June 18.—Traveling salesmen for liquor houses are being discharged and the market is flooded with second-hand fixtures for bars as a result of the prohibition elections in many Oregon counties. The large territory which many salesmen made regularly in the past will now be dry and these men will have to seek elsewhere for employment. How many salesmen have been put out of work is not known, but one Portland house agent is said to have released seven.

There are said to be furnishings for 150 first-class bars on the market, and at least 500 billiard and pool tables. Drummers are now flocking into Idaho and Washington offering barstools in fixtures and tables. In the Lewiston country the saloonmen have been offered expensive billiard tables at their own price and they have been offered the most elaborate bar equipments for less than the cost of manufacture. The market is generally glutted with saloon paraphernalia, because so many saloons have been put out of business.
