ONE NORMAL SURE TO GO.
Board of Regents Meets Tuesday in Salem to Decide Which One.

SALEM, Or., June 22—The Board of Regents of Oregon State Normal Schools will hold its annual meeting in this city on Tuesday of next week and it is probable that at that time the normal school question will be practically settled.

While the Board has no absolute power in the matter and the question of how many and which normals shall be maintained is one for the legislature to determine, yet it was understood when the Board was created that future Legislatures would be governed largely by the recommendations of the Board.

That there will be an effort at the board meeting to recommend the abandonment of one and perhaps two of the normals is certain.

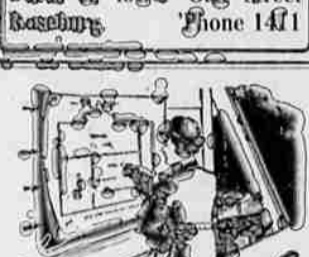

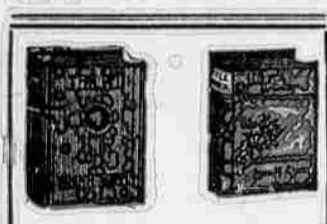
