Supreme Court Rules Against Estate of S. Marks & Co. SALEM, Ore., June 23.—The Supreme court today affirmed the case of Raskalov vs. Row, et al., respondents, from Clackamas county.

The plaintiffs in the above case are heirs of the Mark estate, living in Russia. After the death of S. Marks in Roseburg they were paid \$15,000 for what was supposed to be a full settlement of their share of the estate.
