INCREASE PARCELS POST.

WASHINGTON, June 30.—After today, under a parcels post agreement with Great Britain, parcels up to a weight limit of eleven pounds may be mailed to England, Scotland and Ireland. Postmaster General Meyer believes that this will materially increase the number of parcels sent to the United Kingdom and from the countries composing it to the United States. At the present time, a package weighing in excess of four pounds six ounces cannot be sent in the mails to the United Kingdom.
There are now thirty-three foreign countries with which we have parcels post connections; with nine, the weight limit is four pounds six ounces, and with twenty-four it is eleven pounds. It is the intention to make the maximum weight eleven pounds in all countries.
Owing to the objections of the express companies, however, this weight limit will not apply to points within the United States.
