S. A. Kendall, H. J. Frear and others left this afternoon for a visit to the big timber land holdings of Kendall Bros. on the North Umpqua above Rock Creek. They expect to return Sunday. This is Mr. Kendall's first visit to that region, his brother having been there two or three times during his visits here from Pittsburg. Mr. Kendall has had the work commenced on doubling their power plant and equipment at Winchester. New wheel pits and forebay are being put in and three more big water wheels are to be placed there right away in addition to the three already in place. Another big electric generator has been ordered, doubling the capacity of that portion of the plant also. Another big engine and two more boilers are also to be added this fall, thus providing ample equipment for all emergencies. Work on these improvements is already under way and will be pushed to completion. The expenditures therefor will approximate \$10,000. Roseburg's water and electric service will be kept at the highest standard hereafter. Mr. Kendall has no definite statement to make as to their big sawmilling business in this vicinity at this time, but active operations may be taken up next year.
