NEUHAUSEN RESIGNS. Quits Interior Department to Enter Timber Land Business.

PORTLAND, Or., Sept. 15.—In accordance with his declaration, publicly announced last February, that he intended to quit the government service as soon as his duties would permit, Thomas B. Neuhausen wired the secretary of the interior Monday as follows:

"Although deeply appreciative of prospective appointment October 1 as Indian inspector, I feel that I should take advantage of present business opportunities assuring greater financial rewards than government service. I therefore respectfully tender my resignation herewith, subject to customary transfer of government records and property. To expedite acceptance of resignation, I therefore request, in order that Prosecutors Hensley, Becker and McCourt may immediately formulate such changes as my resignation may necessitate in plans for land fraud trial of 10 defendants on October 12 and of Binger Hermann on November 2, also of other defendants later, I expect to remain in Portland and my testimony will be available under duress legal process."

The telegram according to Mr. Neuhausen's request arrived last night. Mr. Neuhausen has been associated with the prosecution of the Oregon land frauds for nearly four years and has participated in every trial since the "11-7" case. Since it became known that he intended to resign his position with the government he has been offered several salaries positions but he has declined all of them.

LABORERS SUPPORT GOMPERS. San Francisco Unions Adopt Resolutions Endorsing his Action.

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 15.—A resolution endorsing "The course, policy and action of President Samuel G. Gompers and the executive council of the American Federation of Labor in pointing to the wage-owners of our country the proper course for them to pursue at the coming general election," was adopted at the state labor party convention last night as a compromise measure between the resolution endorsing Bryan and omitting all mention of the Communist from the platform.

The platform as adopted for the initiative and referendum, free text books, stricter banking laws, postal saving bank, a direct primary and equal suffrage.
