The Hinkle herd of Red Polled cattle is doubtless one of the best in the Pacific Northwest, and under his personal care it is improving right along and winning an increased number of prizes each succeeding year. The Red Polled breed occupies a high position among what is known as "dual purpose" cattle—that is to say they are valuable both for dairying and as beef stock. Such a combination is especially favorable for farmers who, while producing some beef animals, also require productive dairying stock.

Mr. Alley Won 22 Prizes.
Also of special interest to Douglas county is the splendid record made by F. E. Alley's blooded horses at the Salem and Portland livestock exhibitions. Since his return Mr. Alley has been showing to his friends 22 fine premium badges, representing his winnings in the competitions as above stated. Two of these are championship badges, and one-third of the remainder represent first premiums. This is a remarkably fine showing, considering the fact that there were on exhibition horses not only from all the Pacific Coast states, but from the east as well, including imported stock.

A Trick With a Shirt Waist.

SPEAKS FOR JOE CANNON.

Vice Presidential Nominee Shows His True Colors.

DANVILLE, Ill., Sept. 30.—Last night four members of Congress, one of whom is the Republican Vice Presidential nominee, James S. Sherman, delivered addresses pleading with the voters of this section to re-elect to Congress Speaker Joseph C. Cannon, who has been their representative for 35 years. Special trains brought hundreds of people here from nearby points to hear the speeches and see the huge torchlight parade. Some time ago the bishops of the Methodist Episcopal church in this district united in an appeal to the voters to defeat Mr. Cannon for re-election, charging he refused to let the Littlefield bill relating to interstate commerce in liquors be reported out of committee for passage at the last session of congress. The rally last night was devoted for the purpose of strengthening the Speaker's position in his home district.
