J. W. Morrow, tax and land agent of the O. & C. R. R., and Supt. Thatcher, of the Pacific States Tel and Tel. Co., are in the city on business before the Board of Equalization. Assessor Staley has assessed the O. & C. R. R. (Southern Pacific) roadbed, right of way and rolling stock at \$44,250 per mile, an increase of \$14,250 over the valuation fixed last year. Naturally, the railroad company is objecting vigorously, but its chances of getting a reduction are very slight. A report filed by the O. & C. R. R. with the railroad commission last year placed the value of the roadbed, right of way and rolling stock at near \$30,000 per mile. Mr. Thatcher will appear before the board this afternoon.

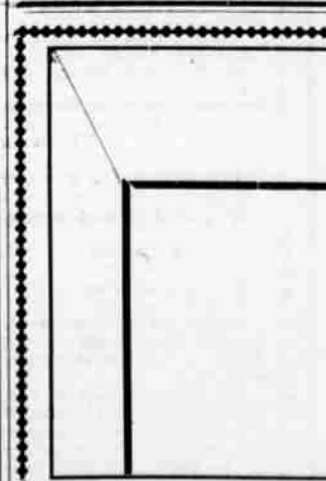

The biggest individual bounty warrant ever issued by a clerk of Douglas County was received from Clerk E. H. Lenox today by "Bill" Bradley, the lone resident of Caps Hill, near the headwaters of the North Umpqua river, 70 miles east of here. Bradley presented to the county clerk the scalps of 37 coyotes and badgers, which, at \$10 apiece, brought him a total bounty of \$370. All of the animals were slain by Bradley between Aug. 15 and Oct. 10, of this year. Some he poisoned, other he trapped while the remainder he shot after they had been bayed by his fine English bloodhound.
