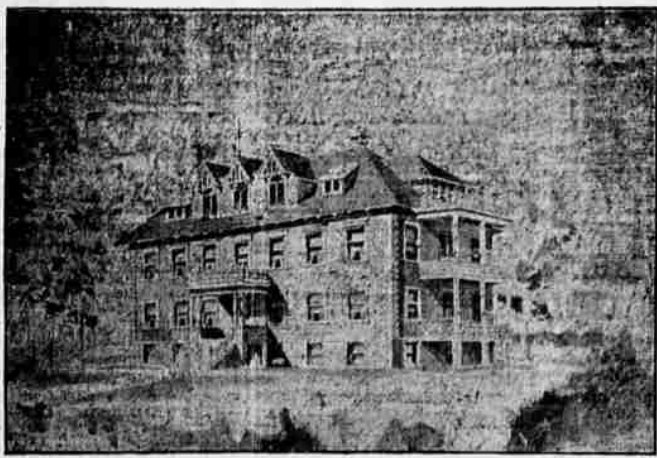

CATHOLIC GOVT. CHANGE.

ROME, Oct. 27.—Next Tuesday, a week from today, will be one of the most important in the history of the American hierarchy of the Catholic church, since it is then that the recent Papal document Sapientia Canonice will go into effect. The document is considered by churchmen the most important that has been issued for the government of the Catholic church in many centuries, and is of special interest to American and all English-speaking Catholics.

By a stroke of the pen Pius X. has recognized the Catholics outside of Italy and has ordered that nearly two hundred bishops, twenty-five thousand priests and thirty millions of the Catholic laity in English speaking countries shall have their affairs examined and decided according to the general law of the church and by ten different congregations instead of one.

Briefly, the document is divided into three parts, and defines the authority of the various congregations and tribunals. It elevates to an important position in the church two bodies that seemed to be about to die of inanition, the Consistorial Congregation and the famous tribunal known as the Sacred Roman Rota. It is to these bodies that American prelates probably will be nominated. They will be the most important of the Curia when the reform becomes operative. The Consistorial Congregation will be, in fact, the head of all, and, according to the document, the reigning Pontiff will be the prefect. That congregation will be charged with the election of nearly all the Latin bishops throughout the world, the founding and dividing of dioceses, the examination of diocesan reports as well as the supervision of the work of all bishops.
