SALE OF STATE LANDS.

Total of 243,216 Acres Sold in Past Two Years.

SALEM, Or., Nov. 2.—The sale of state lands of all classes during the biennial period beginning October 1, 1906, and ending September 30, 1908, has amounted to 243,216 acres, and the amount received as principal on these sales and on tracts heretofore sold under certificates of sale aggregates \$741,236.86. The lands sold are classified as follows: School lands, including farms, 225,257 acres; Agricultural College lands, 1200 acres; University farms, 320 acres; tidelands, 2602 acres; swamp lands, 3836 acres. This is shown by the biennial report of the clerk of the State Land Board, G. G. Brown, made public this morning.

The report also shows, by reference to the report of State Treasurer Steel, which is forthcoming, that the loans from the common school fund October 1, 1908, amounted to \$3,723,539. The outstanding loans from this fund at this date amount to \$4,206,713, so that the net increase amounts to \$483,423. The surplus of the common school fund principal is \$299,311, \$288,426.87 of which is on deposit with the Title Guarantee & Trust Company, and is now drawing 5 per cent interest, leaving an available cash balance of \$1,484,86.

The outstanding loans from the Agricultural College fund, principal, amount to \$190,162.54, and the net increase during the period is \$26,499.38. The amount of this fund now in the hands of the State Treasurer is \$1166.96. The outstanding loans of the university fund, principal, amounts to \$98,875, and the net increase amounts to \$4028. The amount of this fund now in the hands of the Treasurer is \$840.30.

October 21, 1907, the board advanced the price of indemnity school land from \$7.50 to \$8.75 per acre net to purchaser, all filing charges, etc., being paid by the state and charged to the school fund, principal, account. The board has also advanced the price of school and other state lands to not less than \$5 per acre.

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tions and covered 35,852.63 acres, was repaid the sum of \$25,315.79, principal, and \$3729.58 interest. Of this acreage, 29,569 acres are included within existing forest reserves and can be used as basis for indemnity selection at \$8.75 per acre.

The statistical report shows that a total of \$823,020.37 has been received by the department and paid over to the state treasurer; the interest bearing funds in this department at the close of the report period amounted to \$676,254.77, and the amount due interest account from these funds for excess received on farm sales is \$17,970.85. The total amount of lands sold, of all classes was 243,216.41 acres and the total amount of certificates of sale cancelled was 102,853.69 acres. The total amount of repayments made on school, indemnity, swamp and grand jury certificates was \$115,133.70.
