### O. A. C. ENROLLMENT.

Present Total 1000—Douglas County Represented by 24.

There are at present enrolled at the Oregon Agricultural College 1,000 students, of which 24 are from Douglas county. Every county in the state, except Lake, is represented at the institution. About 30 per cent of the students are self-supporting. Many of them are heads of families. About 50 per cent of the students are partly self-sustaining. Of the total number of students, 257 are women.

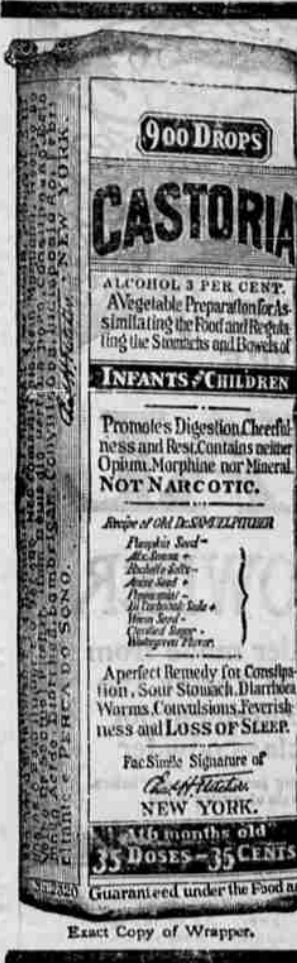
