OREGON NEWS.

At Merlin, Thursday night, the complete stock of the Merlin Supply company was destroyed by fire.

The Secretary of the Interior has withdrawn from entry two small tracts in Clatsop county, with a view of creating national parks.

Robert McCulley shot and killed Con Fhuacane, 29 miles from Lakeview, Wednesday. Both wore sheepmen. They quarreled and the shooting followed.

The annual meeting of the Oregon State Horticultural Society and the Northwest Fruitgrowers' Association will be held jointly, at Woodman Hall, Portland, December 1 to 4, inclusive.

Within 24 hours after leaving his home at Cove, Wash., to enter the ranks of the hobo fraternity, William Knockstead, 21 years of age, suffered the accidental amputation of both legs above the knees by falling beneath a moving train in the Portland terminal yards.
