Arthur Mahoney today bought the Roseburg Cigar Store from J. T. Goodman, who may engage in other business in this city. Mr. Goodman is now negotiating for the sale of his two ranches at Looking Glass California parties. Mr. Mahoney is the former proprietor of the Roseburg Soda Works and was later engaged in the planing mill business in North Roseburg.
Among the bills that will be introduced at the coming session of the legislature will be one by Senator-elect Albert Abraham, of this city, proposing to do away with involuntary nonsuit and motion to direct verdict, and preserving the substance of such practice after a verdict. The purpose of such a change would be to avoid the unnecessary expense of resubmitting the case to another jury, should the ruling of the trial court be reversed, and the further purpose of avoiding the possible effect upon the jury in any intimation of opinion by the judge as to the facts upon overruling such motions. Under the proposed law a jurist will not have the right to instruct a jury to bring in any certain verdict, but, on the other hand, the evidence must be submitted to the jury, who will determine as to whether declaring a nonsuit or otherwise. However, the judge may reverse the opinion of the jury. Mr. Abraham claims this proposed law, if passed, will operate in favor of the poor man.

A marriage license has been issued to Martin Hakanson, aged 39, and Lizzie A. Carlson, aged 15, both of Gardiner.

EIGHTH GRADE EXAMINATIONS

Dates and Programs Fixed for Douglas County Schools.

The regular eighth grade examinations in the public schools of Douglas County during the year 1909, will be held on the following dates:
January 21-22, 1909.
May 12-14, 1909.
September 2-3, 1909.

Program.

Thursdays—Arithmetic, Writing, History and Civil Government.
Fridays—Grammar, Physiology, Geography and Spelling.

Sources of Questions.
Civil Government—United States Constitution.

Geography—State course of study, Redway and Hinman's Natural School Geography.

History—List of topics from History outline in State Course of Study and Current Events.

Language—Buchler's Modern English Grammar, no diagramming.

Reading—The teacher will send to the County Superintendent the applicant's class standing in reading, which shall be taken by such superintendent as the applicant's standing on the subject.

Spelling—Eighty per cent from Reed's Word Lessons, and twenty per cent from manuscript in Language.

Writing—Specimens of penmanship as indicated in copied matter from manuscript in Language.

All teachers having a class wishing to take the eighth grade examination must notify me not later than 10 days preceding the examination, stating the number in his or her school desiring to take said examination.
