Alec C. McRae, the book expert, who has been examining and checking up the financial records of the County, presented his final report to the county court in special session this morning. The reports were accepted by the county, and Mr. McRae was given a warrant for \$600 in payment for his work.

County Treas. Sawyer's accounts were found correct; the books of H. T. McClallen, former sheriff, were found delinquent in only one item, while those of Z. N. Agee, former county clerk, disclosed a shortage of \$512.92. The sum in Mr. McClallen's books which was not accounted for is \$17.80, received on a payment of tax penalty and interest. Mr. McClallen was present when the expert's report was presented and immediately tendered a check in payment of the discrepancy. He stated, however, that he could probably account for the sum later on. Of Mr. Agee's shortage, \$412 represents fees collected for various purposes, while the remaining \$100 consists of a fine imposed in the circuit court and paid to him. Mr. Agee, who is now a traveling salesman, will arrive in the city in a few days, when the matter will be brought to his attention. That he will make a satisfactory explanation and any restitution that may be necessary is not doubted for a moment by any person acquainted with his unswerving honesty and integrity. The expert's report contains a number of recommendations for a better system of bookkeeping, also the suggestion that county warrants be no longer made payable to "bearer," but upon order only.

ASSESSMENT ROLL SUMMARY FOR 1908.

According to the summary of the assessment roll, just completed by County Assessor George W. Staley, the total value of all taxable property in Douglas county is \$23,888,500, or only \$208,225 more than that of 1907. A comparison with the summary of 1907, shows that the heaviest increases made by Mr. Staley are in improvements of town lots and in deeded and patented lands.
