### SLAUGHTER OF WORKINGMEN.

Nearly 35,000 Killed in Accidents in United States in Past Year.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Dec. 14.—Between 30,000 and 35,000 deaths and 2,000,000 injured in the accident record of the United States during the year among workingmen, according to a bulletin on accidents issued today by the Bureau of Labor. Of those employed in factories and in workshops it is stated that probably

the most exposed class are the workers in iron and steel mills. Fatal accidents among electrical workers and iron and coal miners are said to be excessive while railroad trainmen in the proportion of 7.46 deaths per 1000 employees. The bulletin declares that much more could be done for the protection of the workmen, but that it is neglected. Many far-reaching improvements have been introduced in factories during the last decade.
