Weather Observer Bell reports heavy frosts at Los Angeles and San Francisco this morning and killing frosts at Sacramento and Red Bluffs, Calif. Lowest temperatures at other places were: Roseburg, 25; Portland, 22; Tonopah, 19; Baker City, 2 above zero and Pocatello, 8 below. He explains this cold wave as being due to the high atmospheric pressure prevailing from the Rocky Mountains to the Pacific Ocean, the crest being over Idaho and the inter-mountain region and slowly moving in a southeasterly direction.
