30 QUAKES IN 5 DAYS.

VIRGINIA CITY, Mont., Dec. 26.—Thirty earthquakes have been felt in this section since last Sunday afternoon.
The ground has trembled very perceptibly with the earth wave apparently coming from the south, which has lent color to the theory that a big geyser is about to burst forth in Yellowstone park, which lies about 75 miles southeast of Virginia City.
No damage has resulted, other than that considerable plaster has been thrown down.

McClachlin, Jr., Fourth field artillery, U. S. Army, is designated to make the annual inspection. Roseburg's date is Tuesday, January 26.
