"HERMANN'S FRIENDS" AFRAID OF ME"—HENRY

Declares Tawney Helped to Expedite Crooked Claims. Hence His Attack in Congress.

SEATTLE, Wash., Aug. 5.—"I have been treading too closely on the toes of a number of Tawney's friends to please the Minnesota Congressman. I am willing to bet that if the records of the general land office are examined it will be found that Tawney was one of the fellows who helped to get crooked claims expedited."

Tawney thought by discrediting me he could pave the way to getting the Oregon land fraud cases dismissed, thereby leaving his friends in possession of the lands involved, and also save his friend, Hinger Hermann, from being prosecuted by me, whom they are afraid of."

The above statement was the curt answer that Francis J. Heney, the San Francisco graft prosecutor, made here today to the attacks which have been made against the prosecutor on the floor of Congress by James A. Tawney, of Minnesota.

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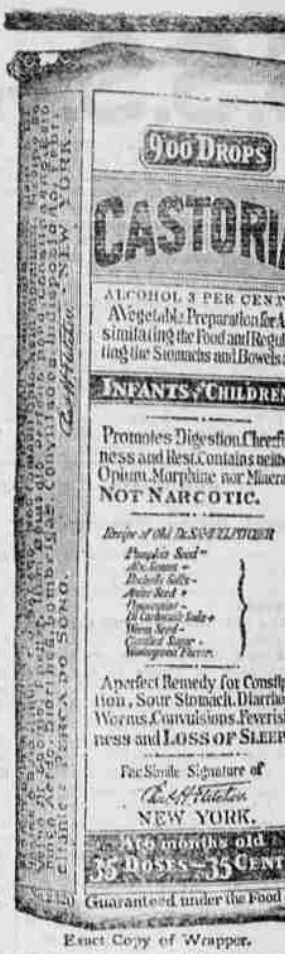
