HUGE ENGINES FOR THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC.

Probably the most remarkable locomotive order in the history of railroads is now being delivered to the Southern Pacific. It consists of 33 freight engines of the Mallet compound type. Twenty-one of these are of the same size as the two which are now at work on the mountain division of the Southern Pacific. These engines weigh 200 tons, and are in fact two locomotives in one. A peculiar fact is that some of the railroads between the eastern works and the western destination refused to haul them over their tracks, fearing both for the tracks and the bridges. Despite this fact the Southern Pacific ordered 20 locomotives of this kind and weight, knowing that they were not especially hard on track. Each of the monsters cost \$30,000.
