COOS BAY AS AN IMPORTANT HILL FACTOR.

New York Paper Says He Must Build Here or Be Exposed for Harriman System.

According to the New York Herald, Hill will have to build a line to Coos Bay or his new lines in Southern and Central Oregon will be merely "feeder" lines for the Harriman system. This new view of the Coos Bay situation is of decided interest here as it presents another phase of the importance of this section in the railroad world. The statement is made in a page article appearing in the New York Sunday Herald, and the gist of it is so far as Coos Bay is concerned, is as follows:

"It is assumed that when the Deschutes road connects with the Southern Pacific Railway at Klamath Falls it will become a real through line between San Francisco and Portland, taking to the latter city the products of Southwestern Oregon that now go to the former city.

"Odell seems to be destined to become a future railway center of great importance. In addition to having the Hill Oregon Trunk Line and the Harriman Southern Pacific and Deschutes line, the Oregon Short Line has obtained right of way to it across Southern Oregon from Ontario to Coos Bay, and will build to it by the time the rival roads get to it.

HOW RAILROADS RULE.

WASHINGTON, June 21.—The millionaire colony of the Senate, some of the members of which own stock in railroads, fought desperately to kill every physical valuation amendment proposed, in the new railroad bill just passed.

A physical valuation would expose to the country the extent to which railroad stocks have been watered, and would, therefore, tend to prevent over-capitalization in the future and pave the way for reasonable freight and passenger rates. This is why the railroads fear it.

The Interstate Commerce Commission, partisan Republican in make-up, has recommended physical valuation year after year. "The Commission has, in previous reports, expressed the opinion that it would be wise for Congress to make provision for a physical valuation of railroad properties, and desires to reaffirm in this report its confidence in the wisdom of such a measure."

Physical valuation was recommended by Roosevelt time and time again. This is at least one Roosevelt policy that Mr. Taft has deserted cold-bloodedly. The President has raised neither voice nor pen on behalf of physical valuation.

Yet the Supreme Court, in the Nebraska rate case, held that "the basis of all calculations as to the reasonableness of rates must be the fair value of the property being used for the convenience of the public." As the Interstate Commerce Commission does not know the value of a single railroad, it must fix reasonable rates by sheer guesswork.

But when it is considered that Harriman contributed \$260,000 to the Republican campaign fund on behalf of the railroads, that probably numerous other railroad magnates advanced equally large sums, and that the very bill Congress is about to place upon the statute books was originally drawn in New York and submitted to the railroad interests before being introduced to Congress, it is not so strange that physical valuation amendments received their death stab even after passed by a goodly majority in the House of Representatives.
