### NEGLIGENCE OF REPRESENTATIVES HURTS PORTLAND.

House Public Buildings Bill Contains No Provision for Postoffice or Site.

WASHINGTON, June 20.—The failure of the House to get into the public buildings bill any provision for the new Portland postoffice building and site caused Senator Bourne to get busy today trying to secure an amendment to the bill when it comes from the House.

Bourne had previously procured the passage through the Senate of a bill appropriating \$1,000,000 for a building and \$500,000 for a site, the building to be devoted to postal uses only, but Ellis failed to get the item into the bill as reported by the House committee.

Such failure will make it doubly difficult to get the Portland item into the bill now and the effort may fail. Even if anything gets in it may be for a site only, the building awaiting future action.

### LIGHTNING AFTER FOUR GOVERNORS.
