### MAKE PIN CUSHION OUT OF REFRACTORY PUPIL.

Lebanon School Teachers Now Face Prosecution by Father of Injured Boy.

LEBANON, Or., March 20.—A boy named Williams has been under the care of a physician for the past several days, suffering from hundreds of tiny wounds inflicted by fellow students with pins in the Lebanon school. The wounds were made at the instigation of one of the teachers and Superintendent F. M. Stotler, who, it is alleged, stood over the boy with a whip while the pupils in turn inflicted the wounds.

A. G. Williams, father of the injured boy, has appealed to the school board and the State Superintendent of Schools. He states that if either does not take the matter up he will apply to the courts.

It is said that this mode of punishment was devised by the boy's teacher after the boy had mischievously stuck some of the students in nearby seats with a pin.

The boy, it is said, at first refused to walk down the aisles when commanded by his teacher, and the superintendent was called in, who followed with a stick until he had marched over the room, receiving hundreds of painful wounds.

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### ROOSTER PUTS MAN AND HIS WIFE TO FLIGHT.

READING, Pa., March 20.—Jacob Latashaw and wife, living at Ontonagon, this county, was attacked and badly injured by a Plymouth Rock rooster. Mr. Latashaw is unable to walk as the result of his experience.

Mrs. Latashaw went to feed the chickens when suddenly the rooster jumped at her, striking her furiously with his spurs on her face and breast. She ran toward the house and the bird followed. Mr. Latashaw responded to his wife's cries, and the rooster flew at him and sank his spurs into his instep, puncturing an artery. He was also struck on the face.

After Latashaw and his wife reached the house the rooster strutted about the yard and crowed incessantly over his double victory.

### SPENCER WITHDRAWS PROTEST.

EUGENE, Or., March 20.—Carlton Spencer, the Cottage Grove orator who challenged the legality of the judges' decision awarding the honor of university orator to Charles Robinson, has acquiesced in the decision, the matter has been dropped and a second tryout will not be held. The controversy, however, has brought out a point that will make it possible for any team dissatisfied with the decision rendered at the state oratorical contest last week, in which Spencer won, to make a protest.

Medford Tribune: E. S. Brooks, who first broke into the limelight in Medford some months ago when he "confessed" to the murder of Belle Ellis, whose body was found alongside the Southern Pacific railroad tracks and was later committed to the state asylum for the insane at Salem, only to be discharged as "cured," is again in the hands of the officers. He is at present lodged in the city jail awaiting the arrival of attendants from the asylum who will take him back to the institution. Brooks has been "off" several times of late and it was deemed necessary to arrest him on Thursday night after he prowled around the city for hours, finally falling unconscious. Brooks declared that he is not crazy but says that he cannot "control his mind." He has been suffering from insomnia and this is thought to be responsible for his present condition.

### PASMORE TRIO THURSDAY.

While the Pasmore Trio, that noted group of American musicians who are to appear at the Presbyterian church on Thursday night, March 23, was in San Francisco, a special concert was arranged for them in the mammoth Greek amphitheatre, located on the campus of the University of California. This is the theatre in which such celebrities as Sara Bernhardt, Maud Adams, Harold and Dr. Ludwig Wullner have appeared. Telling of their concert there, Walter Anthony, critic of the San Francisco Call, said:

"A splendid audience, an enthusiastic as it was large, greeted three young ladies, who ask no condescension for their art and plead no forbearance for their years. They just play."

Miss Dorothy played the Saint-Saens A-minor concerto. Her reading of the difficult number was scholarly and sure, her intonation correct and her left hand firm and unflinching. Particularly appealing was her tone in the allegretto movement, which she repeated for an encore. From the first short dissonant chords to the finale, she was mistress of the situation and played with emotional fervor and academic accuracy.

Her sister, Miss Mary, presented Lalo's Spanish symphony, op. 21, with its familiar "Rondo" allegro finale. The essence of her presentation was delicacy and purity. It is difficult to gauge tone size in the Greek Theatre. The distance separating player from auditor is so great that reasonable breadth of tone is surprising; you do not expect so much volume. Her tone was broad, full and of an alluring sweetness and beauty. She plays from the heart. A delicious bit was her interpretation of Kreisler's favorite song piece, Dvorak's "Humoresque," which, even with the giant's rendition still in our ears, was done with rare charm and expressiveness.

Great interest is being taken in the coming of the Pasmore Trio to this city, and an immense audience will greet them.
