public utilities owned by the city are damaged or become out of repair, the council may issue warrants to the amount of \$10,000, and must provide for their payment at the next annual tax levy.

LIQUOR SELLING CLUB MEN AT WOODBURN ARE FINED.

WOODBURN, Or., April 20.—The trial today of J. C. Moore, secretary of the Bachelors' Club of this city, on the charge of violating the ordinance prohibiting the disposal of intoxicating liquors, resulted in a decision of guilty on six counts by Recorder Stangle, who imposed fines aggregating \$550 and costs.

Al Edgar was also found guilty of selling liquor in the Bachelors' Club and fined \$50 and costs. The only witnesses in these cases were Detectives White and Dermott, and the defense made the most of this fact. No evidence was offered by the defense. All the cases will be appealed to the Circuit Court, where the defense will seek to impeach the two detectives and will contend that the ordinance is not in harmony with the Woodburn city charter.

The cases against Henry Helmken, charged with violating the same ordinance at his place of business, formerly conducted as a saloon, has been continued. The defendant is charged on four counts with selling intoxicants to Detectives White and McDermott.

Yesterday J. P. Meehan, president of the club, was found guilty of having violated this city ordinance on four counts, the fines aggregating \$350 with costs of the action, with the prosecution offering the only evidence in the case.

TAFT REFUSES PARDON TO FRANKLIN P. MAYES.

PORTLAND, Or., April 21.—President Taft's refusal to pardon Franklin Pierce Mayes' petition for a pardon. Mayes will be compelled to serve four months in the county jail and to pay a fine of \$10,000. This fine was imposed upon him in September, 1906.

The Blue Mountain case is the one in which the President refused to commute sentences. Mayes was indicted in this case February 13, 1905, with Willard N. Jones, John H. Mitchell, Ringer Hermann, John N. Whitson and George Sorenson. Conspiracy to defraud the Government of valuable land in the Blue Mountain forest reserve was the charge.

MEDFORD GIVES CONTRACT TO CLARK-HENRY COMPANY.

Asphaltic Concrete Pavement Bid \$1.71 Square Yard.—Committee of Council to Inspect.

MEDFORD, Or., April 21.—The city council at a special session held Wednesday afternoon accepted the bid of the Clark & Henry Construction Company for the paving of many additional streets in this city and instructed the city attorney to draw up an ordinance entering into a contract with the firm. The council has decided to accept the asphaltic concrete pavement offered by the company at \$1.71 a square yard but has 30 days to specify a change should they decide to accept the 5/8 pavement as is laid at present or the 5-1-1 1-2 offered for \$1.76 a square yard. With the additional streets to pave and those included in the contract now under way but not as yet completed, the company has approximately 250,000 square yards of pavement to lay in the city before they finish the work here.

Asphaltic Concrete.

The asphaltic pavement to be laid according to present indications is new to the city but has been in use in other cities on the Coast for the past ten years. Instead of laying a concrete base as is the case in the pavement now being laid the company mixes crushed rock, sand and gravel at the plant with asphalt and after rolling this on the street the same wearing surface as is now being laid is placed on top. This assures a splendid binding and a far less percentage of voids as is the case where asphalt is laid on concrete. The base, being composed as it is of asphalt and crushed rock, heats when the hot material for the wearing surface is placed upon it, and this allows the wearing surface and the base to amalgamate perfectly. The material for the base and the wearing surface is all put through the plant and is laid on the street at a temperature between 200 and 300 degrees.

Has Been Tried Out.

This pavement has been tried out thoroughly in different California cities and after being down for nine years has been found to be in excellent condition. In order to inspect different kinds of paving three members of the city council will in all probability leave in the near future for Sacramento, where they will inspect the work done by the Clark & Henry Company.
