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NEW EVIDENCE AGAINST LOCHARD IS DAMAGING.

Seen Near Lodging House On Night of Crime—Hawkes Goes Back to Penitentiary.

PORTLAND, Or., Dec. 21.—Information which tends to weave still stronger about Lewis G. Lochard, the murderer of 4-year-old Barbara Holman in an Albion lodging house March 12, was furnished Deputy Sheriff Leonard yesterday by T. Ambrose, a laborer.

Ambrose declares almost with the emphasis of certainty that Lochard is the man he saw near the corner of Mississippi avenue and Russell street in the immediate vicinity of the murder scene about 3 o'clock the morning of March 12. The man who committed the deed had raised the room the afternoon before and it was about 10 o'clock of the morning referred to by Ambrose that the discovery of the murder was made by Mrs. Bertha Nelson, the landlady.

The parole from the State Penitentiary of J. P. Hawkes, the wealthy East Side resident implicated in a series of wholesale thefts by the confession of Lochard, was yesterday revoked by Governor West. Hawkes was rearrested yesterday and last night was taken back to Salem to serve the remainder of an indeterminate sentence of from one to ten years inflicted by Judge Gantenbein for horse stealing on February 6, 1908.

GENERAL NEWS.

The House of Representatives has passed the Pray bill authorizing homestead entrymen whose lands were burned over by forest fires during the summer of 1910 to sell timber on their homesteads that was killed or seriously injured by fire.

Rose Kytinge, once one of the famous actresses of the country, and also known as a writer and dramatist, died Wednesday at the Brunswick Home, Antietam, Md., where she had been living in the care of the Actors' Fund of America. She was 72 years old.

A grandmother at 29 years, mother of eight children and sister-in-law of her own daughter, is the record held by Mrs. William Golden, of Canton, Ill. She was married when 13 years old to Henry Bird. Bird died, and in July, 1910, Mrs. Bird and her oldest daughter, then 14 years old, married Floyd and William Golden, brothers. Mrs. Golden's youngest children are twins, born last Saturday. Her grandchild is 6 months old.

Portland Telegram: At the request of a local automobile sales branch, Secretary of State Olcott has forwarded the number of renewal register tags and new ones for 1912 cars that have been issued up till December 1. The figures are for popular-priced cars only and show models for two to five passengers. Tags for 519 E-M-F automobiles were taken out by the first of this month and 458 for Fords, according to the figures. The third make of motor car to enjoy popularity in Oregon is the Buick, for which 423 tags have been issued. Next in line comes the Cadillac, for which already 423 tags have been sent out. Three hundred and thirty-one Maxwells have been granted permission to run in the state and 245 Chalmers cars have received tags for the same purpose. At the closing of the books November 30, 51 Overlands had been registered. It is estimated that at least 7500 cars will be registered with the Secretary of State this year, as against the 6000 of the season just past and the 5000 of the year previous.

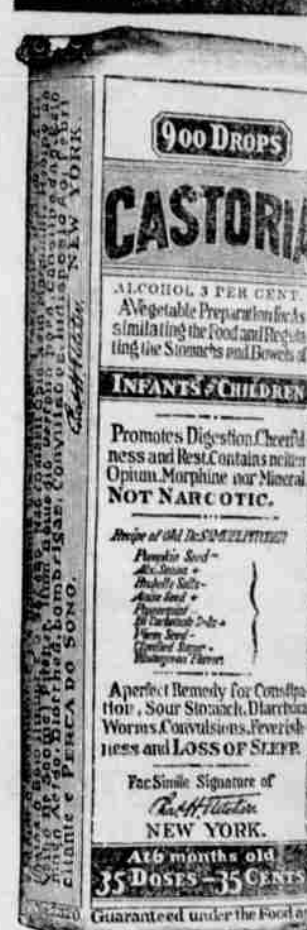
