SLOANE CONCERT ON

DEC. 17 WILL BE RARE

TREAT FOR ROSEBURG.

Roseburg music lovers are assured of a splendid treat in the concert of Miss Sloane, to be given at the Armory on next Tuesday evening, December 17. She will be assisted by the Madrigal Quartet, directed by Prof. G. A. Fory. An exceptionally fine program has been arranged, and one of the biggest musical successes of the year in the city is promised.

The program to be rendered is one that requires the versatility of an artist for its successful rendition. In operatic aria, Scotch ballad or melodious love song of Lehmann or D'Hardelot, Miss Sloane is equally at home. She sings with dramatic fervor in the arias from grand opera, in which she is at her best, and shows the effect of the finished training with master instructors, which has been here.

range, the richness of the low tones and the extreme clearness of the high tones being fully demonstrated in her numbers last evening.
