ANCIENT TIMES RECALLED BY GARDINER GAZETTE; SCOTTSBURG OLD TOWN (From the Gardiner Courier). The following is taken from the Portland Telegram and was written by David W. Hazen. The time the Weekly Gazette referred to was published, Scottsburg was the principal town in Southern Oregon. Being at the head of navigation on the Umpqua River, and a shipping point to the interior and to the southern part of the state: Ireland's songs were ever singing in the heart of Daniel Jackson Lyon, the first blind editor of Oregon. His paper, the Umpqua Weekly Gazette, published at Scottsburg, was the first in this territory south of Salem. Captain Levi Scott, founder of the town, was the prime mover in starting the publication. Its first appearance was made late in April, 1854, the Oregon Statesman of May 9th having the following editorial announcement with the heading "New Paper in Oregon": "We have received the first number of the Umpqua Weekly Gazette, published at Scottsburg, and devoted to literature, agriculture, mining news and general intelligence." We welcome the Gazette as the pioneer paper of Southern Oregon, and wish it every success. Lyon was a native of Ireland and a graduate of one of its colleges. He had worked on New York and Louisville papers before coming to Oregon. Relatives read to him and he dictated his copy to them. There are only four known copies of the Gazette in existence; they are "somewhere" in the Oregon Historical society's collection. News was scarce in Scottsburg on the Umpqua in those days. The Statesman clipped a string of notes from the June 1st issue of the Gazette, the most exciting of the items being: "Business in Scottsburg has been increasing steadily for the last three weeks." "The miners in the vicinity of Randolph are doing well." "Robert Shortess runs a semi-monthly express from Port Orford to Scottsburg, via Randolph and Empire City." Some time about midsummer, 1854, William J. Beags became editor of the paper. He announced that the Gazette would be neutral as regards political matters. During this period certain men with political bias began urging a new territory; they proposed to carve it out of Southern Oregon and Northern California. Early in the summer the Gazette published a letter from Joe Lane, Oregon Territory's delegate in Congress, a part of which follows: "Some time since I wrote a letter for publication in relation to the division of Oregon territory, as proposed by the people of Jacksonville and Yreka. In which I gave my views in opposition to such division, and urged the establishment of a state government, for reasons I think will be considered legitimate and proper. A new territory cannot be made as proposed. The delegation from California don't think of entertaining the idea of clipping their state." Vessels from San Francisco visited Scottsburg, and the citizens of the Umpqua country thought it was to be the big city of Oregon. They told how a railroad would be built from there to tap the Willamette and other valleys, and that the products of those districts would be hauled to Scottsburg's busy wharves. Today the town is little more than a memory. The Statesman of November 21 says: "B. D. Boyd, late of Portland and Corvallis, has purchased one-half of the Umpqua Gazette. W. J. Beags owns the other half. It is edited by Beags and Boyd, and is hereafter to be a Democratic paper." In May, 1855, it published a letter about a prominent Portland Whig, who was said to be a temperance advocate, "drinking profusely on the evening that he made a speech in this place." Under the heading of "About Newspapers," the Statesman's leader for October 13, 1855, says: "A slip from the Umpqua Gazette office announces the discontinuance of that paper. By our Jacksonville correspondence we are informed that the press is to be taken there and a paper published under the editorial supervision of S. H. Taylor, Esq. Mr. Taylor, we believe, has had some editorial experience in the States. He is a good writer and an excellent man, and we heartily wish his new enterprise success." Mr. Boyd, an editor of the Gazette, witnessed a good degree of true editorial tact and talent, and the paper, under his control, was always medium. "There are now six papers in Oregon; we cannot afford that number a living support, and some of them must die." Then followed a long discourse on the newspaper profession and its trials. But in spite of the warnings given by Editor Boyd, his paper made the following announcement on December 8, 1855: "We have received the first number of the Jacksonville paper. It is called the 'Table Rock Sentinel,' and is published by Messrs. T. Vaulx (Colonel) William G. T. Vaulx, Taylor and Blakey, the two first named being the editors, we understand it is published on the Umpqua Gazette materials, and resembles that paper in typographical appearance. Scottsburg's vision of glory vanished with its newspaper. Mrs. F. A. Kerr and little daughter returned to their home at Eugene yesterday afternoon, after a short visit here.
