GORDON STEWART HAS RIGHT TO CHARGE FOR PERMISSION TO BATHE The Review has received a number of letters during the past few days asking for information as to whether Gordon Stewart has a legal right to charge a fee of 10 cents, or any other sum, for bathing in the Umpqua River abutting Alexander's Park. For the benefit of these persons a Review representative today visited a prominent Roseburg attorney and ascertained that Mr. Stewart is acting clearly within the law. The Umpqua River at the point of the swimming hole is not a navigable stream, and consequently the lease on the land acquired by Mr. Stewart extends to the center of the stream. Mr. Stewart not only has a right to charge persons who enter the river over his land, but he could so far as they are desired and refuse to admit them to his premises altogether. The attorney also contended that Mr. Stewart could legally refuse to allow persons to bathe in the river abutting his property unless they remained at a point beyond the middle of the stream. Roseburg attorneys say this point of law is well defined, and Mr. Stewart is acting within his rights when he charges admission to his land of the river abutting his property.
