A teacher who is a natural leader of people and who will put his whole energy into such leadership, can develop such ideals along moral, religious, and economic lines that this work will be noticeable years after he has left that community.

ESTABLISHING SCHOOL IN FRANCE FOR EDUCATION OF WAR ORPHANS

PARIS, Feb. 15.—American Methodists, as part of the church's \$120,000,000 Centenary movement, have just completed an investment of \$50,000 in purchasing a site at Grenoble for an institution where war orphans may be educated and cared for.

Hardened down with a tremendous war debt, France has been unable to do as foster mother to all the thousands of children who have been left without parents," said Dr. Frank Mason North, head of the Methodist delegation now in Europe which made the arrangements. "Schools, such as the one just founded, are designed to be insurance policies for the future of France."

Forty thousand dollars of the money spent came through the Board of Foreign Missions in the form of special gifts and the remaining \$20,000 from the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society. The institution already is endowed with \$10,000, which has been contributed toward its maintenance.

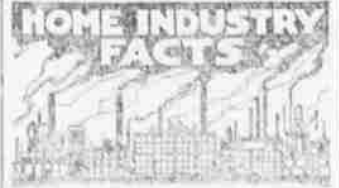
