LEGISLATURE NEAR END.

cannot be sold on the open market, should the bill pass the Senate and finally become a law. Warden Stevens will be permitted to put the men in the penitentiary to work and also give them employment on the outside, for which they will receive compensation. The bill was introduced by request of Warden Stevens.

A road tax of one cent a gallon on gasoline and one-half cent on diesel oil was voted by the Senate yesterday afternoon when House bill 124 was passed without opposition.

Figures were presented by Senator Orin showing that approximately 1,000,000 gallons of gasoline and 1,000,000 gallons of diesel oil are used in Oregon annually, and the tax just voted will produce a revenue of \$51,000 a year. This fund will go into the road fund.

As the bill carries an emergency clause, the tax will be in effect as soon as the Governor approves the bill.
