

**Poultry Industry Rapidly Growing**

Douglas county has made greater strides in the production of poultry and poultry products during the past year than ever before. Since the county agent has held demonstrations over the county, all being conducted under supervision of poultry experts from the Oregon Agricultural college the men and women who have heretofore made guess work out of the business, are now working on a well-founded system and figure returns as well as expenses, says the Portland Telegram.

Douglas county and the Umpqua valley are favored for poultry raising on account of the even temperature, and the assurance that green feed can be had the year round. The large commercial poultry plants are nearly all raising White Leghorns, and going in for eggs.

All the chicks are incubator hatched, and those who do not hatch their own chicks buy day old chicks and raise them with the large colony brooders.

Fully fifty thousand chicks were hatched in the vicinity of Roseburg this spring for the local plants, while that many more were shipped out. The system of selecting or culling out the flocks so that all non-producers will be eliminated is in common use by all poultrymen.

Feeding is a very essential part of the business and has been figured down to a science. The kinds of feed for results are not the cheapest grains on the market (which are the most expensive to feed) but the best of several different kinds of grain and corn—as well as a variety of ground food or meal. With the housing and feeding well looked after, the hen that does not give a yearly return of \$3 profit is not considered worth keeping, and is sent to the market for meat.

The Oregon Poultry Producers association has a branch in Douglas county and most of the producers are members of the association. Through this association they are able to get better market returns and can assure the consumer of strictly fresh eggs in every shipment. The eggs are gathered twice daily, shipped twice a week, and all labeled "Nulade" eggs.

As a turkey producing county Douglas county holds the record of the Pacific Northwest. No other county in the state, nor in any other state ships as many turkeys to the fancy holiday trade as does Douglas county.

The quality is the highest, and for the past few years has brought a higher price than turkeys from any other section of the country. Portland, Seattle and San Francisco markets all clamor for Douglas county turkeys.


