Dorothy Phillips' first picture since "Destiny" will be seen at the Antlers theatre tonight. "Paid in Advance," the new production is based on the story of the Canadian Northwest and the Klondike, by James Oliver Curwood, who is recognized throughout this country and Canada as one of the foremost students of life in that region, as well as the creator of entrancing stories. He is said to be the only American ever engaged by the British Government to do exploratory and descriptive writing. His collection of game photographs is known to be the largest in America.

"Paid in Advance" is rich in situations and scenes. The story begins in the fur country of Canada, and enough of the story is given to give an excellent knowledge of the manners and customs of the heterogeneous people who inhabit that region. In "Paid in Advance," she is cast as Joan Gray, the daughter of a fur trader in Dawson City by the unscrupulous proprietor of a notorious dive who promises her work as a nurse and amuses her that her father will become wealthy as an expert fur buyer.

Other notable names are in the cast, among them being Priscilla Dean, herself a Universal star, William Stowell, who plays the leading man, Joseph Gerard, Lon Chaney, Frank Brownlee and Bill Bures.

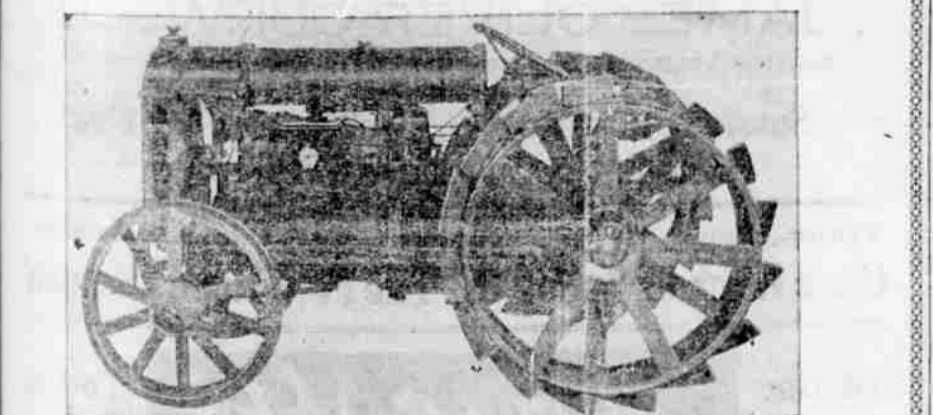
