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BOLSHEVISM AND HUMAN NATURE.

Many people who recognize that there is little tendency to bolshevism in America are afraid that the new menace, having swept over Poland, will over-run western Europe and then work harm in many ways to American ideals and institutions.

Modern civilization, despite its soft spots, is pretty tough, on the whole. And Bolshevism, like any other ism, is no stronger than human nature. Now, what is the history of radicalism, with individuals, groups and nations? Turned successful, what happens to it?

For a "close up," emblematic of the whole business, look at France. There was never any more radical nation than the French, in their red revolution. And what followed? Submission to an emperor, and then gradual development of solid democratic institutions combining personal liberty with property rights.

That is already happening in Russia. The peasants, having got possession of the land, are determined to keep it, not in common, but individually. Lenin in industry is compromising with the bourgeois class.

NIGHT RIDING AROUSES SOUTH

Sentiment Is Against the Lawlessness Which Is Result of Ignorance.
