Phone Rate Lift Proposal Sought

PORTLAND, Dec. 22.—Decided differences of opinion as to the proper time to tamper with existing telephone rates, in view of the general downward trend of production costs in all lines, developed yesterday at the hearing held before the Oregon public service commission for the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph company for a general increase of 30 per cent over its present rates throughout this state.

While officials of the company, as outlined in the opening statement of James T. Shaw, general counsel, testified that the plant is inadequate to cope with the business now offered it, and that further extensions and improvements are essential to the welfare of the enterprise and the progress of Oregon, the city of Portland, as represented by W. P. LaRoche, city attorney, and the representatives of various other communities, emphatically protested the logic of the application.

It is declared by the company that the cost of necessary extensions and improvements approximate \$5,000,000, and that rates must be advanced to a point where returns on the investment will render the securities of the company attractive to purchasers. In almost every instance, it was declared, and attested by exhibits, the operations of the telephone system in Oregon communities are being conducted at a loss, with a deficit of \$491,000 for the present year, and an estimated deficit of \$824,000 for 1927.

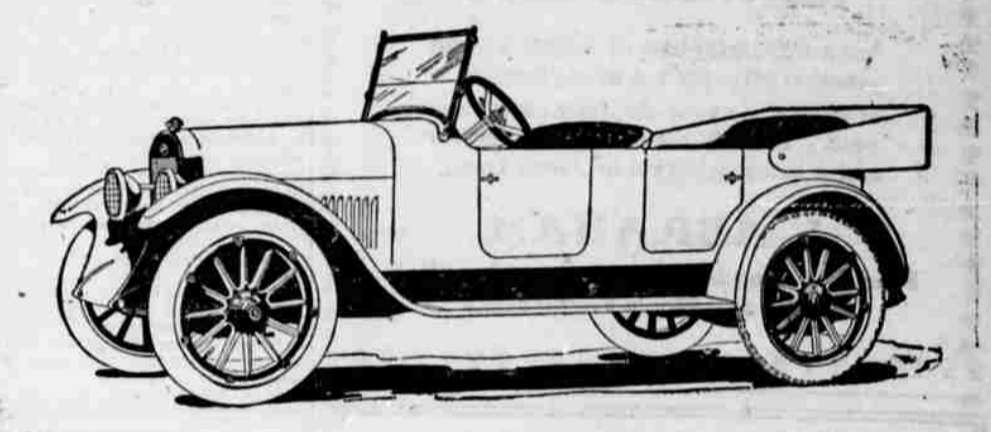
