Owing to the fallure of the city attorney to draft the ordinance re-quested by the board of fire commissioners relative to the repair of wood-en buildings damaged by fire within the business district, the commisthe business district, the commis-sioners were forced to grant the request of H. Marks to repair the buildings directly north of the Lib-erty theater, which were damaged by fire a few days ago. At the former fire in these buildings the commis-sioners endeavored to force demo-lition of the structures, but because of a weakness in the ordinance the owner succeeded in having them reowner succeeded in having them re-paired. The commissioners then re-quested a new ordinance, but up to the present time it has not been drafted and presented to the coun-cil and consequently the commis-sioners must be guided by the old regulations.

These provide that a building may be repaired unless damaged 40 percent or more. Contractors who have investigated the buildings where the fire occurred stated that the dam-age amounted to 32 or 35 per cent and consequently the commissioners have no alternative but to allow re pairs to be made.
