SEEK 4 OVERHEAD CROSSINGS TO SPAN SOUTHERN PACIFIC
SALEM, Dec. 24.—Authority to construct four overhead crossings of the Pacific highway over the tracks of the Southern Pacific railroad at Oakland, Sutherland, Wilbur and Shady Point in Douglas county, is asked in applications filed with the public service commission Thursday by the state highway commission.

It is estimated that the construction of these four overhead crossings will involve the expenditure of approximately \$270,000. Six existing grade crossings will be eliminated by the four overheads, according to the application.

MOONSHINE OUTFIT FOUND UNDERGROUND
MARSHFIELD, Dec. 24.—Z. G. Harshman was arrested Wednesday night by Sheriff Ellingsen and other officers and two complete stills which he was operating were seized. The officers found a complete underground apartment where the moonshining had been carried on. Harshman is known as a partner of J. S. Stevens who is now in jail for moonshining. Harshman served a term in McNeille Island penitentiary and also served terms in Washington, and at Salem for holding up trains.

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
