Taxpayers Urge Millage Tax Cut

BAKER, Ore., March 14.—Abolition of millage taxes for schools, limitation of voting on financial measures to taxpayers only and cancellation of every appropriation that can be eliminated were some of the suggestions received by the state tax investigation commission from officers and taxpayers of Baker and Malheur counties today.

Why did the legislature appropriate more than \$100,000 for armories when the nations of the world are disarming and navies are being junked and standing armies reduced, demanded one citizen.

Children are being taught all sorts of folders and there are instructors for folders and fancies, declared another taxpayer. On the other hand, Andrew M. Graham, assessor of Malheur county, insisted that the counties are all right and can take care of themselves, but that the heavy tax burden is caused by the state.

Members of the commission who have come into eastern Oregon to seek suggestions for tax remedies and to gather first-hand information as to conditions consist of I. N. Day, C. E. McKenna, C. S. Chapman and Walter M. Pierce.

Out of a \$56 per capita for all purposes in Oregon only \$1.96 per capita is for strictly state purposes.

The way to reduce taxes is to not levy them and then public officials will not have the money to spend. Tax increase 524 Per Cent. Population in Oregon from 1910 to 1921 has increased 18 per cent and property values have increased in the same period 26.8 per cent.
