Logger Believed To Have Killed Self

MARSHFIELD, March 23, E. G. Pinkerton, an employee of Smith-Powers logging camp No. 6, this side of Powers, disappeared yesterday after leaving a note willing his auto and other personal effects to Wm. Pett and saying they would find his body in the "swimming hole."

Foreman Wm. Garret and other employees traced Pinkerton to the water's edge. The river is high and they have been unable to find any trace of the body, as the current would probably carry the body far. Pinkerton has some cousins living on North Inlet. He had been employed at various logging camps in the section for several years. He was a tall man and was known to fellow employees as "Slim."

He had been in a rather despondent mood for some days and yesterday drew his time. Then he came down and left the note for Pett, to whom he owed some money, saying that he could have his auto, watch and other personal effects and that his body would be found in the river. Coroner Wilson has given instructions to try and locate the body. Pinkerton was unmarried and nearing middle age.
