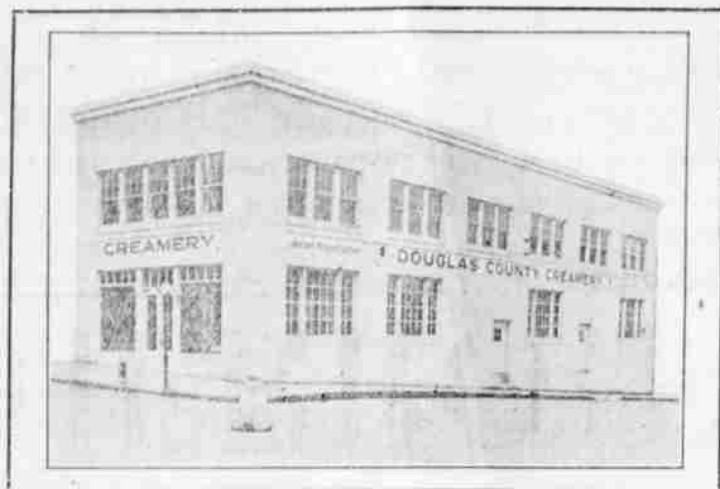

ENGLAND ASKS FRANCE FOR CASH

(By United Press.) PARIS, April 5.—The French government received a note from England amounting to a demand for immediate payment by France of the interest due on the money France borrowed from Great Britain, amounting to two and a half billions. England must pay in October 25,000,000 pounds interest on the money due the United States and feels that the allies should pay her something. Action will probably be taken by England refusing to renew a three-year convention, made in 1919, whereby France is relieved of paying interest on the money borrowed from England. France has intimated that payment is impossible.

HARDING TO MAKE BIG HOUSECLEANING

(By United Press.) WASHINGTON, April 5.—Democrats and others not in sympathy with Harding's policy will be discouraged shortly, according to an announcement made today. This will amount to the dismissal of approximately 2000 democrats of all ranks in the government service and in every department, including prohibition enforcement. Harding has announced his intention of "house cleaning" regardless of criticism.

HAS RIGHT TO PROTECT OWN WIFE

(By United Press.) OKLAHOMA CITY, April 5.—Under the Oklahoma code, a man's home is inviolate, the circumstance of which many believe will prevent Judge Jean Day from going to trial on a murder charge for the killing of Lieut.-Col. Paul Beck, aviator, when he found the latter forcing his attentions on Mrs. Day. The case is being thoroughly investigated. Will Make Inquiry. WASHINGTON, April 5.—The army court of inquiry will investigate the death of Lieut.-Col. Paul Ward Beck, whom Judge Jean Day admitted he killed when he discovered the officer making improper advances to Mrs. Day.
