Prof. Weigant who introduced the recirculator system for driers spoke briefly on this topic and reports were received from growers who tried out the new system this year, the reports showing a very fine condition and a general approval of the new drier method.

M. J. Newhouse of the Oregon Growers' Cooperative association spoke on the work of that organization and gave some interesting information regarding market conditions.
