Nelson, by publication thereof in the Roseburg News-Review, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Roseburg, County of Douglas, State of Oregon, and that said publication be made not less than once a week for two consecutive weeks.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of the inventory, petition and subpoena to answer, duly verified thereto, be mailed to respondent at the City of Roseburg, County of Douglas, State of Oregon, the last known address; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said J. E. Nelson, alleged bankrupt and respondent herein, be and he hereby is granted and given up to and including the 21st day of Dec., 1922, to answer, or otherwise appear and plead herein, that in default of answer, he be adjudicated an involuntary bankrupt in accordance with the bankruptcy laws and the rules and practices of this court.
