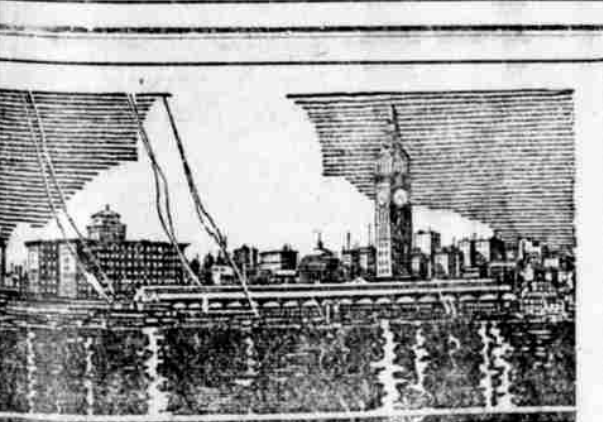

AMERICAN JEWS DISTRIBUTE \$9,000,000 FOR RELIEF WORK

(By Associated Press.) NEW YORK, March 12.—More than \$5,700,000 has been contributed by American Jews toward non-sectarian relief in Russia, and a further \$3,200,000 mostly for their own people through the American Relief Administration during the year 1922, according to a report of the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee.

About \$4,000,000 of the \$5,700,000 was directly contributed toward Russian relief from the organization's own funds, while the remainder was made up of the 25 per cent deducted by the American Relief Administration for general relief from approximately \$7,000,000 in food packages sent by American Jews to Russia.
