Our county trout fisheries are opening their banks in readiness for the opening of the trout season. If the weather conditions tomorrow, hundreds of small fish will be swimming the streams in the county in an effort to find the fish for which the Valley is noted. In this section it is well for the angler to keep in mind the fact that certain streams in Douglas county have been closed indefinitely by order of the game commission, in order to provide protection for the fish in those streams. The creeks affected by this order are: Lake Creek for a distance of 900 yards below a point where said creek emerges from Diamond lake; Cow Creek and all tributaries thereof, above a point on said creek known as Laymon's hollow; the mouth of Azalea Smith River for a distance of 600 feet below the falls known as South river falls, located approximately eight miles above the Jack Daily place.
