CHINA DRUG PLOT LAID TO GERMANS

Opium Association Reveals Bribe
Offer to Customs Officer
At Shanghai.

(International News Service.)

PEKING, June 5.—The alleged attempt of Germany to force narcotics into China is described in a recent issue of the International Opium Association Bulletin published here. The organization charges that within the last few months a bribe of \$160,000 (Mexican), which is \$50,000 American, was offered the customs officials in Shanghai to allow a shipment from Dresden of heroin valued at \$250,000 (Mexican.)

The emulsion referred to by the bulletin consisted of 1,150 one pound tins of acid acetylo-salicylic (chemical name for Aspirin), manufactured by Gehe & Company, Dresden, and exported from Hamburg. Analysis proved that the acid content of the tins was heroin. It is the opinion of the anti-opium organization that the large shipment was not the property of an individual trafficker, but of a large financial ring to whom the loss of one shipment would be trifling. When the discovery of the true contents was made the bribe of \$50,000 was immediately offered.

The organization here is watching with keen interest the efforts of the United States to bring about the prohibition of the manufacture of heroin.
